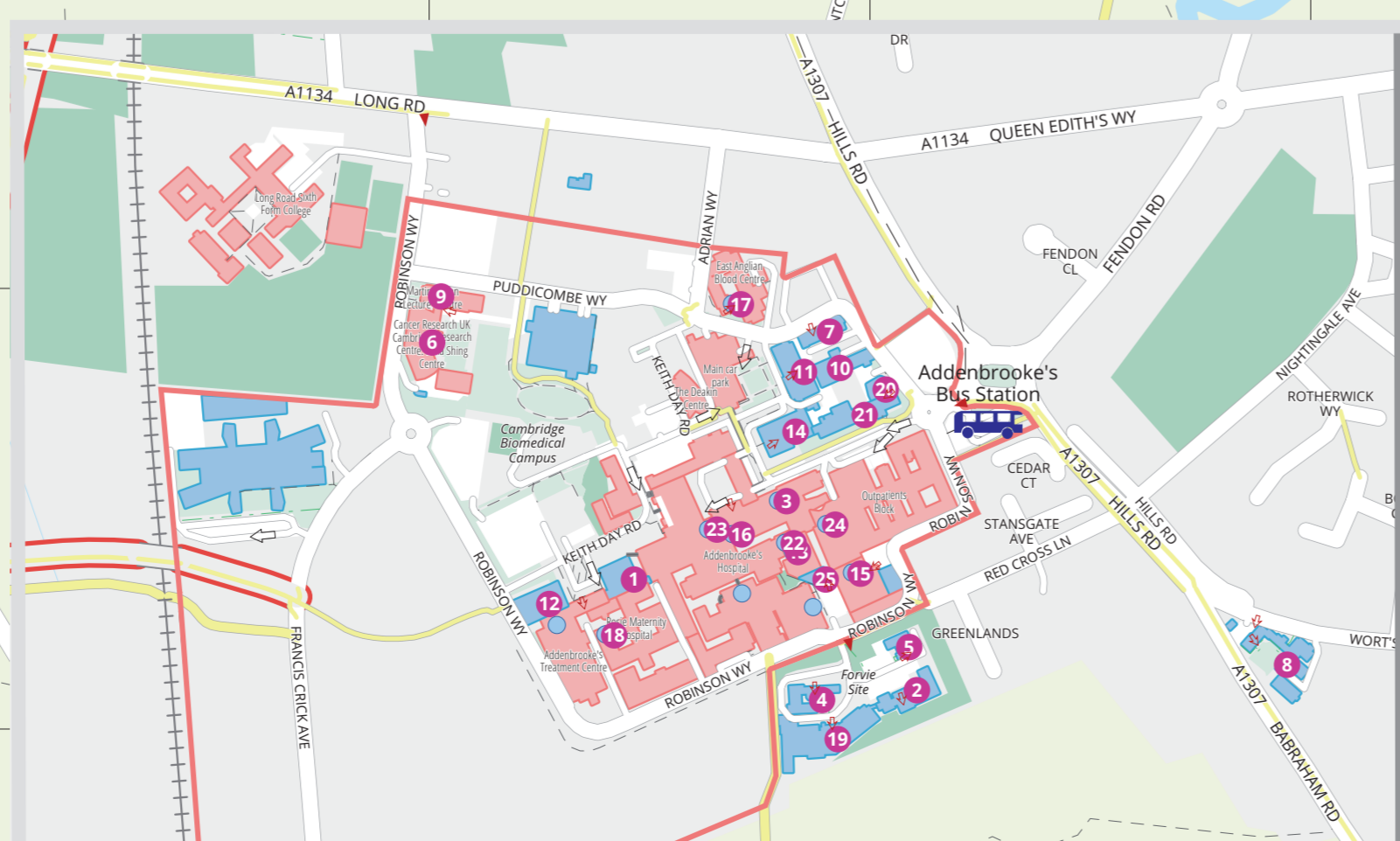

University of Cambridge Official Map

This map shows the location of the colleges, departments, research institutions, main libraries, lecture theatres and administrative offices of the University of Cambridge. A number of related nonuniversity establishments are also marked.

How to use the map
The index is arranged alphabetically. There is a separate index for the colleges.

All the places on the main and central area maps are identified with numbers in coloured circles. Those in the dense city centre sites are located more precisely in the central area map, otherwise on the main map, including with a grid reference in both cases. The Addenbrooke's and Madingley areas have their own insets at the same scale as they are just off the south and west of the main map respectively.

Places beyond the area of the main map are shown on the Cambridge region inset map.

Transport

Parking in Cambridge
Parking in Cambridge is very limited and visitors are advised to use public transport, especially the Park & Ride service marked at five locations around the city. For university or college parking please contact the department or college in advance for advice on availability.

Access for disabled people
The disability resource centre website www.cam.ac.uk/disability provides details about access for disabled people to university facilities belonging to the university or colleges, including some detailed maps showing access for people with mobility impairments and parking for disabled people. Most colleges and larger departments have parking spaces reserved for blue badge holders, but these may not be available at the time you visit. If you would like to know more please contact the College or department in advance to make arrangements or for any other queries about access.

Uni 4 bus service
